The Johnson County Board of Supervisors is accepting grant applications for Social Services Emergency or Innovative Flexible Funding Grants. Up to \$22,000 in funding may be awarded to non-profit, charitable organizations providing services to Johnson County residents. This funding is being made available for the current state fiscal year.

The funding is intended to assist with short-term or one time needs of organizations. Funding may support capacity building, sustaining of services, innovative new programming or the purchase of equipment/supplies. Priority will be given to proposals that address emergency needs, health services and/or improve the physical/or emotional well-being of Johnson County residents most in need and address gaps in services in the county.
