Origin: **Resolution 01-30-97-01** Adopting the Johnson County Integrated Roadside Vegetation Management Plan

Number of Members: Any number of persons; considering representation from persons involved in the following disciplines/interests/industries:

- The utility industry;
- The University of Iowa or a State Regents Institution/Academy of Sciences;
- County Government, as a current Johnson County employee;
- The private sector, including community interest groups;
- Soil conservation;
- The Iowa Department of Natural Resources or the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers;
- The Johnson County Conservation Board; or
- The farm community.

Appointed by: The Johnson County Board of Supervisors and recommended by the Johnson County Engineer

Term: Three (3) years

Duties: Include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Researching efforts;
2. Demonstrating projects;
3. Education and orientation for property owners, public officials, and the general public;
4. Activities of the integrated roadside vegetation manager;
5. Reviewing applications for funding assistance;
6. Securing funding for research and demonstrations; and
7. Performing liaisons with other organizations for integrated roadside vegetation management purposes.
