

## COMPREHENSIVE PLAN COMMITTEE – JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA

- Origin:** Established via contract with JEO Consulting Group Inc, by the Johnson County Board of Supervisors as an advisory committee for the plan consultant, County staff, the Planning and Zoning Committee, and the Board.
- Number of Members:** Up to twenty-one (21) members. The following constituencies are preferred, but not required: persons with knowledge of County government and land use planning issues; commodity growers and producers; small farmers; conservationists and environmentalists; engineering consultants; academics with specialized knowledge in related fields such as planning; and interested residents with varied experience and from different parts of Johnson County.
- Appointed by:** Johnson County Board of Supervisors
- Term:** Starting November 1, 2016 - for a term of approximately 18 months - or until a final draft of the plan is submitted to the Planning & Zoning Commission, which is anticipated to happen by November 2017.
- Duties:** The Comprehensive Plan Committee will: a.) develop the County's vision statement; b.) hold public meetings to assist in the development of goals, objectives, and policies for the comprehensive plan; and c.) review plan drafts and maps and suggest changes or revisions to these items throughout the process.
- The resulting deliverable will be a final draft of the updated plan, sent to the Planning and Zoning Commission for review and initiating the public hearing process.
- Meetings:** The Committee will have up to six (6) meetings
