MINIMUM WAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE VACANCIES

Johnson County, Iowa — The Johnson County Board of Supervisors announces up to four vacancies on the **Johnson County Minimum Wage Advisory Committee** for three-year terms beginning January 1, 2018 and expiring December 31, 2020.

The Committee provides assistance to the Board of Supervisors by understanding the challenges of low wage workers in our community, the needs of employers, and the impacts of the County's Minimum Wage Ordinance. To develop this understanding, the Committee studies local economic conditions and issues of poverty, while inviting community input, as well as provides educational opportunities for local officials and the public regarding local economic conditions. With this knowledge, the Committee makes recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding implementation of the Ordinance and possible amendments.

In appointing members for the Committee, the Board of Supervisors seeks representation from a wide variety of interests and occupations. The following constituencies are preferred, but not required: labor unions; low income workers; business/employers; academics with specialized knowledge in related fields such as economics, law, social work, etc.; social service providers; state or municipal elected officials; and community groups.
