EMS Association presents educational conference Saturday, Feb. 10

Johnson County, Iowa – The Johnson County Emergency Medical Services Association will present its 31st annual conference for emergency services personnel on Saturday, Feb. 10, at South Slope Center, 980 North Front Street, North Liberty. Check-in and breakfast begin at 7:30 a.m. and the conference will conclude at 4:30 p.m. The conference is free for members of Johnson County EMS Association departments and \$60 for non-JCEMSA department members and the general public. Registration, which can be completed online at <http://www.jcems.org/events/event-registration>, includes lunch, continuing education registration, parking and conference materials.

The conference is intended to meet the educational needs of pre-hospital and in-hospital emergency care providers. Presenters will address topics regarding cardiac care, emergency communication, active shooter response, IPOST and hospice issues, hemorrhage control and tourniquet use, and stress in EMS.

The Johnson County Emergency Medical Services Association was founded in 1988 to foster and advance the delivery of EMS services to the residents of Johnson County. The organization, which represents all agencies providing emergency medical services within Johnson County, is responsible for inter-agency trainings, conferences and joint funding, and promotes cooperation among EMS agencies, law enforcement and hospital partners.
