**JAIL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**MAIL:**

Letters can be mailed to inmates at the Johnson County Jail. They are to be addressed as follows:

Be sure to include your full name and address on the return address.

No letters will be accepted that have stickers affixed, lipstick, perfume or any other foreign substance applied to the letter or envelope.

The jail does not accept any packages mailed in to inmates. Any magazines or books mailed in must come directly from the publisher.

## **ITEMS ACCEPTED AT THE JAIL:**

No property will be accepted for an inmate at the jail except cash and prescription medications in their original bottles or sample medications verified by a doctor.

## **DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION:**

Interested persons may call to inquire information about an inmate. If the person is currently in custody, jail staff can tell you the following information:

- Whether the person is in custody
- What charges they are being held on
- Bond required to be released, if applicable
- Scheduled release date, if applicable

Jail staff **cannot** give out court information. That information can be accessed through the inmate's attorney, or on the internet on "Iowa Courts Online" at [www.iowacourts.state.us/ESAWebApp/SelectFrame](http://www.iowacourts.state.us/ESAWebApp/SelectFrame)

## **COMMISSARY:**

Commissary is available to inmates that have money on their accounts. Order sheets are distributed on Sunday nights at approximately 7:00 pm. The commissary order is delivered and distributed on the following Wednesday (excluding holidays).

Inmates may spend up to \$20.00 per week. Money can be deposited on an inmate's account either at the jail (cash or money orders only) or through the US Mail (Money Orders, No personal checks or cash).

Inmates can order a variety of items on commissary including personal hygiene products, underclothing and snack items.

## **COMMUNICATION:**

Inmates may not receive incoming personal phone calls. Staff is also not able to pass messages to inmates.

Inmates have access to a collect/pre-pay phone system that is handled by "Inmate Calling Solutions". An account can be set up to enable inmates to make outside calls by calling **(888)-506-8407**.
