

**MINUTES OF THE CANVASS OF THE JOHNSON COUNTY BOARD OF  
SUPERVISORS:  
SEPTEMBER 16, 2011**

Chairperson Harney called the Johnson County Board of Supervisors to order in the Johnson County Administration Building at 4:02 p.m. to act as a canvass board to certify the results of the School Board Election of September 13, 2011. Members present were: Pat Harney, Terrence Neuzil, and Rod Sullivan; absent: Janelle Rettig and Sally Stutsman.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Clear Creek Amana Community School District Board Director At Large** (TWO to be elected) there were six hundred three (603) votes cast as follows: Bob Broghammer received one hundred ninety-nine (199) votes, Terry Davis received two hundred thirty-six (236) votes, and Lisa Jiras received one hundred sixty-eight (168) votes, and five (5) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Bob Broghammer and Terry Davis duly elected for the office of Clear Creek Amana Community School Board Director At Large for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Clear Creek Amana Community School District Board Director District 1** (ONE to be elected) there were three hundred forty-six (346) votes cast as follows: Rick Hergert received three hundred forty-six (346) votes, and two (2) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Rick Hergert duly elected for the office of Clear Creek Amana Community School Board Director District 1 for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Clear Creek Amana Community School District Board Director District 3** (ONE to be elected) there were three hundred nine (309) votes cast as follows: Steve Swenka received three hundred nine (309) votes, and eight (8) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Steve Swenka duly elected for the office of Clear Creek Amana Community School District Board Director District 3 for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Iowa City Community School District Board Director To Fill A Vacancy** (ONE to be elected) there were four thousand fifteen (4,015) votes cast as follows: Karla Cook received three thousand one hundred sixty-five (3,165) votes, and Julie VanDyke received eight hundred fifty (850) votes, and twenty (20) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Karla Cook duly elected for the office of Iowa City Community School District Board Director To Fill A Vacancy for the term of 2 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Iowa City Community School District Board Director** (FOUR to be elected) there were fourteen thousand nine hundred sixty-three (14,963) votes cast as follows: Jeff Alden received nine hundred thirty-four (934) votes, Patti Fields received one thousand nine hundred ten (1,910) votes, Phil Hemingway received one thousand eight hundred twenty-one (1,821) votes, Sally Hoelscher received two thousand three hundred five (2,305) votes, Jeff McGinness received two thousand eight hundred fifty-six (2,856) votes, Robert Porter received one thousand five hundred eighty-nine (1,589) votes, Marla Swesey received two thousand nine hundred seventy-six (2,976) votes, James Jim Tate received five hundred seventy-two (572) votes, and seventy-three (73) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Patti Fields, Sally Hoelscher, Jeff McGinness, and Marla Swesey duly elected for the office of Iowa City Community School District Board Director for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Kirkwood Community College Director of District 2** (ONE to be elected) there were one hundred seventy-eight (178) votes cast as follows: Paul Glenn received one hundred seventy-eight (178) votes, and four (4) write-in votes were cast.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Kirkwood Community College Director of District 4** (ONE to be elected) there were eight hundred fifty-five (855) votes cast as follows: Karen Gorham received eight hundred fifty-five (855) votes, and eleven (11) write-in votes were cast.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Kirkwood Community College Director of District 5** (ONE to be elected) there were eight hundred nine (809) votes cast as follows: John Hall received eight hundred nine (809) votes, and thirteen (13) write-in votes were cast.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Lone Tree Community School District Board of Directors** (TWO to be elected) there were three hundred ninety-five (395) votes cast as follows: Sheila Burr received one hundred three (103) votes, Tim Lorack received eighty-nine (89) votes, Joel Yedlik received one hundred fifty-two (152) votes, Kyhl Schmidt received fifty-one (51) write-in votes, and there was one (1) other write-in vote cast.

We therefore declare Sheila Burr and Joel Yedlik duly elected for the office of Lone Tree Community School District Board Director for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE OFFICE OF Solon Community School District Board Director** (TWO to be elected) there were five hundred twenty-four (524) votes cast as follows: Dan Coons received two hundred thirty-eight (238) votes, Dean A. Martin received two hundred twenty (220) votes, Jeremiah Sinnwell received sixty-six (66) votes, and eight (8) write-in votes were cast.

We therefore declare Dan Coons and Dean A. Martin duly elected for the office of Solon Community School District Board Director for the term of 4 years.

**FOR THE PUBLIC MEASURE Proposition A:** To adopt the revenue purpose statement to replace the current Revenue Purpose Statement and authorize the expenditure of revenues from the State of Iowa secure an advanced vision for education fund received by the Solon Community School District there were two hundred ninety-five (295) total votes cast. Two hundred thirty-two (232) votes were cast for the question. Sixty-three (63) votes were cast against the question.

We therefore declare Public Measure Proposition A to be adopted.

**FOR THE PUBLIC MEASURE Public Measure Q:** Bond: Shall the Kirkwood Community College (Merged Area X) in the Counties of Benton, Black Hawk, Buchanan, Cedar, Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque, Iowa, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Jones, Keokuk, Linn, Louisa, Poweshiek, Tama and Washington, be authorized to remodel, erect and equip buildings at the main campus and other enrollment locations, acquire a site or sites for use of the Community College, contract indebtedness therefore, and issue its school bonds in an amount not exceeding \$46,500,000 for that purpose? There were four thousand seven hundred ninety-two (4,792) total votes cast as follows: three thousand nine hundred three (3,903) votes for the question, and eight hundred eighty-nine (889) votes against the question.

**Motion** by Sullivan, second by Neuzil, to approve the results of the School Board Election of September 13, 2011. Roll call: aye: Harney, Neuzil, Sullivan; absent: Rettig, Stutsman.
