

HOW TO CHECK THAT YOUR MAILED BALLOT IS THE CORRECT STYLE

Sample Ballot:

Make sure that the precinct shown on your absentee ballot and affidavit label **MATCH** the precinct on your ballot.

If the ballot style doesn't match the label as indicated below call the Auditor's Office immediately at 319-356-6004. Write "VOID WRONG BALLOT" on the ballot, affidavit envelope, and return carrier envelope and return according to the instructions.
