November. Discussed Caregiver Wellness Day in the Spring. Planning to do it at the Coralville Public Library and have Dr. James Coyle and Marcie Durian as presenters. Welsh to contact Mercy Hospital on what they are doing on Care Act and possible event.

COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE: Monthly newsletters are going well thus far.

<u>FALLS PREVENTION:</u> Kellbach reported activity reports on classes Tai Chi, Stepping on. Looking for spaces to do fall prevention classes. Brief discussion of Fall Prevention Fair. Bob reported on history of this committee how it started.

<u>HOUSING:</u> Tracy reported final Aging in Place forum tomorrow. Committee is looking at having materials available to hand out at home show. The committee has narrowed their list of possible topics for next year's Aging in Place events to Medicaid/Medicare, Fair housing, how to choose a contractor, reverse mortgages, downsizing. They meet later in the month to solidify the 2020 series.

<u>Transportation:</u> Carolyn reported they received answer on Iowa City Transit. Study being done on input from riders. The survey they are doing multi lingual. Consulting group doing the survey._
