

2020-2022 Johnson County Livable Community Strategic Plan Draft

Mission: To serve as a unifying structure that fosters effective collaboration, communication and education that will build and sustain a livable community for successful aging.

Vision: To help Johnson County become a livable community where everyone can age successfully.

Johnson County will be a livable community which has:

- Health and support services
- Transportation and mobility options
- Affordable, accessible and appropriate housing
- Community and economic development
- Cultural, volunteer, life-long learning and employment opportunities
- Public safety

Which together facilitate personal independence and the engagement of residents in civic and social life.

Key Purposes of the JCLC Policy Board:

- Prepare Johnson County to address the needs of an aging population.
- Serve as a unifying structure that brings together common interests and collective resources to foster effective collaboration, cooperation, communication, education and direction of efforts that will build and sustain a livable community for successful aging.

Goal 1: Affirm and promote a common understanding of the JCLC Policy Board

- 1. By June 30, 2020 review strategic plan goals and evaluate progress at each meeting. Coordination: Policy Board
- By December 31, 2020, annual review of action teams/committees to ensure work aligns with goals of Strategic Plan. Mentor new members. Coordination: Committee Chairs, Policy Board
- 3. By February 28, 2021, develop at least one project annually to promote each year as a board. Coordination: Policy Board
- 4. By June 30, 2021, build relationship with Johnson County Board of Supervisors by providing annual report, attending meetings, reporting on aging initiatives of importance and organizations to recognize. Coordination: Executive Committee, Communications Committee

Goal 2: Facilitate communications and educational initiatives

- 1. By July 2021, increase newsletter circulation by 200 people. To publicize, distribute through agencies and retiree mailing lists. Coordination: Communications Committee
- 2. By July 2021, provide a minimum of five forums, presentations, booths and other outreach programs annually in order to educate the public about Johnson County services. Coordination: Policy Board, Action Teams, Aging Specialist
- 3. By July 2021, expand communications with government entities. Speak at council and county meetings, as well as work with large employers to provide educational sessions. Coordination: Policy Board
- 4. By July 2021, complete migration of the Johnson County Livable Community website. Coordination: Communications Committee, Aging Specialist

Goal 3: Effectively advocate to build and sustain Johnson County as a Livable Community

- By July 2021, participate in at least one forum annually with state and local representatives to educate ourselves on issues facing seniors. Coordination: Policy Board
- By June 2020, identify a minimum of one policy issue important to Johnson County seniors and advocate to cities, the county, and state. Coordination: Policy Board

- 3. By June 2020, annual review/ update of continuum of housing options. Coordination: Policy Board/ Aging Specialist
- 4. By July 2021, complete an annual review and identify gaps in services for lowincome older adults. Coordination: Policy Board/ Action Teams
- 5. By December 2021, research livable community designation for Johnson County and determine feasibility. Coordination: Policy Board
