Term:	Five (5) years
Appointed by:	The Board of Supervisors
Duties:	<p>The Conservation Board is responsible for all real and personal property acquired by the county for public museums, parks, playgrounds, recreation centers and other county recreation purposes.</p> <p>The Conservation Board shall plan, develop, preserve, administer, and maintain all such areas previously described.</p> <p>The Conservation Board shall employ a director who shall be responsible to the county Conservation Board for the carry out of the Board's policy.</p>
